Cologne, Germany - (RNS) A protest was made here by the Federation of Roman Catholic Youth in Germany against new "terror sentences" imposed on Zone courts. It urged the German public to demand the release of the imprisoned young people.

The West German youth organization, which claims 750,000 adherents, said that 18 high school students in Werdau, Saxony, recently were sentenced to a total of 130 years in prison for boycott agitation against the (East) German Democratic Re-

According to the Catholic or ganization, the youths, all of them between 16 and 21, were convicted of having distributed anti-Communist leaflets and handbills protesting against the death sentence given to Hermann Jos eph Flade, a Catholic high school student of Olbernhau, Saxony. 


