THRISTMAS is a season of gift-giving. Have you noticed that in , this column we never asked you for a gift for the Holy Father's Missions. We asked only for sacrifices, and how beautifully you T. Callahan, diocesan director. have responded! The reason we asked for sacrifices, was because that is the way The Divine Missionary came to us on the first Christmas day through a sacrifice. First of all, He left the riches of heaven to preach Divine Life on earth. St. Paul says: "He Who; was rich became poor for our sakes, that through His poverty we might be rich". He sacrificed His Majesty as God by tabernacling Himself within His Mother who was a kind of ciborium holding the Host Who would be the Guest of the World. He secrificed Himself by becoming a child, and being wrapped in swaddling bands, which portrayed the way He wrapped up His Divinity in our human form. He sacrificed Himself by not easing the housing situation in His favor in Bethlehem, and by allowing His Mother to take Him under the floor of the earth to be born amongst the beasts.
