Vatican's Right To Voice In U. N. Agencies Defended

Paris (NC) — The Holy See's right to a voice in UNESCO discussions has been defended here by Minister of National Education Andre Marie.

In a statement in the government's Official Journal, the cabinet minister asserted that Archbishop Angelo Roncalli, Papi Nuncio to France, who was Vatican observer at the 1951 general conference of UNESCO in Paris, was within his right in addressing the conference's closing session last July 2.

THE STATEMENT was published in answer to a question asked by the communist bloc in the National Assembly. The communist deputies had asked the government what steps it had taken to enforce observance of "the principle of laicism in UNESCO activities." They claimed that this "principle" had been "obviously violated" by the Archbishop's speech.


