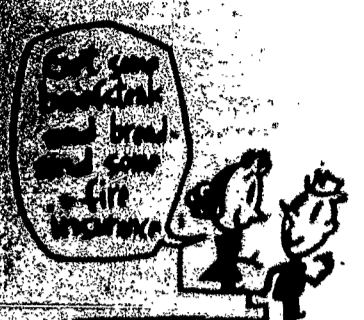

Fr. J. G. Gefell At Fort Slocum Chaplain School

Chaplain (Captain) Joseph G. Gefell of Rochester is now in training at The Chaplain School, Fort Slocum, N. Y. before returning to active duty. The school is in charge of Chaplain (Colonel) Joseph R. Koch, also a native of Rochester.

ON HIS FIRST tour of duty he was sent to the Chaplain School at Fort Devens, Mass. in 1945. There in LeGarde General Hospital, New Orleans before going to Japan. He served in Japan from August 1945 to January, 1947.

The Chaplain School, which is the only training center for chaplains of the Army and Air Force, helps men of all faiths to make the transition from the ministry of the civilian clergyman to that of the military chaplain.

Students are all ordained clergymen. The Chaplain School deals only with such subjects as will enable them to apply their professional skills already mastered, to the requirements of their military service.

Created to furnish mobilization type training for clergymen in World War I, The Chaplain School has carried out its mission: preparing chaplains for a ministry to troops since 1918.

Polio Campaign Seeks Funds To Make Up 1951 Deficit

Rochester headquarters of Monroe County's March of Dimes has been established at the Zenane Hotel on the mezzanine floor, according to Mrs. John L. Wehle, County Campaign Director.

The financial statement of operations of the Monroe County Chapter of the National Foundation for Infantile Paralysis shows that the local chapter has drawn more than \$17,000 from the Epidemic Aid Fund of the National Headquarters to meet emergency needs here.

The same report shows that the Rochester chapter is deeply in debt despite this aid from National Headquarters. According to official estimates, the local chapter will enter the new year with an \$8,000 deficit.
