

Gift Packages

Washington, D.C. -- (RNS) --The Office of International Trade has freed from export controls gift packages up to \$25 in value sent by individuals in the United States to teligious, charitable, or educational organizations abroad. Heretofore, only gilts sent by individuals here to individuals abroad were free from export license requirements.

Gifts sent from one organization to another are not given the exemption, the agency said, since in practice such gifts are usually more than \$25 in value,


