
Gilt Packages

Washington, D.C. — (RNS) — The Office of International Trade gift packages up to \$25 in value sent by individuals in the United Heretofore, only gifts sent by individuals here to individuals abroad were free from export license requirements.

Gifts sent from one organiza tion to another are not given the exemption, the agency said, since in practice such gifts are usually more than \$25 in value.
