Reported Killed In Korea**

Pvt. Gerald E. Kirchner, II, son of Mr. and Mrs. Ferdinand Kirchner, 401 St. Paul Blvd., Irondequoit, has been reported killed in action in Korea. He was a parishioner of St. Thomas Church, Gleebrook Drive.

According to the Defense Department report the youth was killed on the day his last letter home was postmarked. He was killed while fighting with the 1st Infantry Regiment Nov. 26.

Enlisting in the Army last February, Private Kirchner arrived in Korea in October. Before going into the service he was employed by the Lincoln Rochester Trust Company and Eastern Kodak Company.

He was graduated from Iona High School and attended Paul Smith's College for one year, where he was active in the Newman Club.

Besides his parents the Immaculata is survived by a brother, F. Charles Kirchner, who served in the Navy during World War 2.

At the time of his death he was a student at the University of Rochester, where he was a member of the Sigma Chi Fraternity.
