

### Parcel Rates Rise, Size of Packages Cut by New Rules

A new postal card died on Jan. 1, and as part of the traditional card was upped to 2 cents. Parcel rates for special delivery, registry, insurance and COD packages were increased. The maximum rate for a 50-cent parcel was increased to 60 cents. Domestic mail registry fees were increased between five and 25 cents, depending on the value of the item. Unchanged at 10, 15 and 20 cents for values ranging between \$5 and \$25. Insurance fees were raised from 30 to 35 cents for maximum value of \$200. Collect on delivery fees will range from 30 cents to \$1, instead of 20 to 60 cents for values up to \$200.
