

### Bishop Lamb Installation Set Jan. 16

Philadelphia (NC) — Bishop Hugh L. Lamb, Auxiliary of Philadelphia, who has administered the archdiocese since last May when His Eminence Dennis Cardinal Dougherty died, will be installed as Bishop of the new Diocese of Greensburg on January 16. It has been announced.

The Most Rev. John F. O'Hara, C.S.C., who on January 9 will be installed as Archbishop Philadelphia, will be the officiating prelate. The ceremonies will be held in the Most Blessed Sacrament Cathedral in Greensburg. As head of the new See, Bishop Lamb will be the spiritual leader of some 165,000 Catholics in Armstrong, Indiana, Westmoreland and Fayette counties.

### Churches Promised Steel Allocations

Washington, D.C. (RNS) — Failure of the National Production Authority to allocate steel for new church construction projects was due to an "oversight" and will be corrected soon, a high official of that agency promised here.

Most of the 73 church construction projects approved for the first quarter of 1952 out of 74 applications were for projects which qualified under "wardship" provisions of the law in virtue of having been under construction already at the time stringent controls were imposed.

Lewis Allen Weiss, assistant administrator of NPA's Civilian Requirements Division, admitted in an address to religious leaders here that NPA officials had neglected to give adequate consideration to churches when setting up allocation of civilian building materials but he said a new program is being set up that will remedy the situation.

### West German Priests Barred In East Zone

Frankfurt (ING) — Catholic priests now residing in the West zone of Germany are no longer permitted to transfer their residence to communist ruled Eastern Germany according to an edict of Dr. Karl Steinhoff, East zone Secretary of the Interior, who is known for his hostility to religion.

### Parish Schools Ask Negroes' Admission

Louisville, Ky. (RNS) — A proposal that all parishes in the Louisville area should admit Negroes to their parishes was given preliminary approval by the Louisville-Maryland Legislative Committee for admission to the 1952 Kentucky Legislature.

Proposed by the Rev. Felix N. Pitt, secretary of the Louisville Catholic School Board, the measure would be introduced as an amendment to the state segregation act which reads as follows: "It shall be the duty of the Board of Education to provide for the admission of all children to the public schools."
