By JOHN A. GREAVER Leeden - (NC) - The Cath-olics of England and Wales are to build a national strine to their principal 105 martyrs of the Protestant Reformation on the site of their executions in the London West End. The shrine, a church contain-

ing most of the martyrs' relica. will rise from the ruins of the bombed convent overlooking Hyde Park and the Marble Arch. which marked the site of the public gallows of Tyburn of the litteenth and sixteenth centuries. A GENERAL appeal for funds

will be launched with the ap-proval of the Ellerarchy, on May Feast of the English Martyre. The shrine will supersede the hattered Tyburn Convent of the Adorers of the Sacred Heart, which, up to the blitz days of World War II, was the center of countless pligrimages in honor of the men and wemen, cieric and lay, who suffered there so ter

It will mark the termination of the annual "Tyburn Walk" across the capital each spring from the other Church of the English Martyra near the Tower of London and from the old Newgate Jail along the route of the martyra' last journey to be hanged, drawn and quartered.
