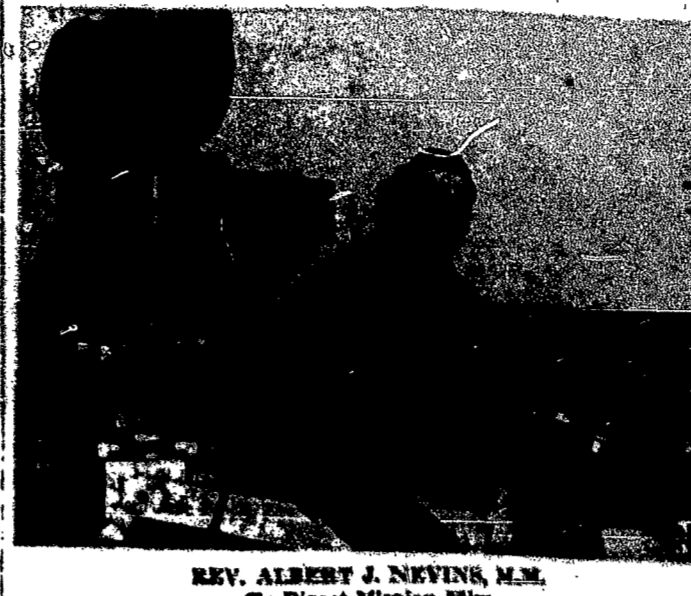
Guild Offers Play On Purification

Hollywood In Focus

Catholics Are Latecomers Says Harry Simonson

"Catholics certainly are latecomers" says Mr. Harry Simonson, contributing editor of "Film World." Hollywood's movie industry is not even beginning to catch up with the mass of Catholics in the United States. It means latecomers to the movie and does not mean late to attend them, but late to make use of them as a source of spiritual ends.

In 1947 there were 1,000 churches within the United States, mostly in the Catholic Church, which were running an average of one regular film show by 1951 that figure had risen to 10,000.

Still, among America's 10,000 Catholic parishes, I have yet to hear of one which makes regular use of the motion picture in its religious, social, educational or hold together social mission or hold together social mission of the faith.

The facts are painful, from a Catholic point of view. For they prove that the children of the Most Holy Trinity Church, completely ignorant of the modern methods of communication such as movies, to spread their beliefs.

It is, of course, of course, that many Protestant communities utilize films in forms of service within the churches themselves whereas by reason of the glory of the Real Presence, Catholic Churches provide no place for anything of the kind.

Yet we cannot look for better things until by habit and demand, we have created a steady and remunerative market for them. The producers of "Upon This Rock" a fine, Catholic-inspired life of Christ, lost their entire while an inferior film on the same subject, released by others with less concern for consistently high quality and more working capital, made a hit with them.
