**Catholic Press '52 Directory To Run 8,000 Copies**

A 1952 edition of the Catholic Press Directory will be published, as a result of the successful publication of the first edition by the Catholic Press Association last year, according to the NCWC News Service from New York.

An increase in space orders resulting from the first edition was the main reason for authorizing another edition, according to the CPA's national office here. Other reasons included the rising volume of calls to the national office for rate information, the publication's financial soundness, and the prestige gained for the association.

According to Msgr. John S. Randall, issuing editor of the Rochester Diocese's Courier Journal and chairman of the CPA press directory committee, at least 8,000 copies of the directory will be printed. About 8,000 copies will go to advertising agencies and advertisers, and the balance will be distributed on a paid basis. The directory will be printed by the Christopher Press, 35 St. St., Rochester.
