AMONG WOMEN

Family Apostolate

One of the aims of the Family Apostolate is to encourage family religious practices. At the outset, let us remember that the Church helps the family through the graces it offers the individual members through Holy Mass, the Sacraments, the Rosary, and various devotional exercises.

From this viewpoint there are a number of religious practices which should be encouraged. The Bureau lists first Sacraments in the Home and states: "Sacramentals are blessing or blessed articles. They are, for instance, holy water, blessed medals and pictures, blessed candles and palm, the blessed wedding ring, the blessing we give ourselves as we make the Sign of the Cross. Another sacramental is the blessing of the home or dwelling place."

There are many blessings for mother and children. These should appeal to every Catholic parent because they center in the child, the primary purpose of marriage. There is actually a whole group of these blessings, some of them centering in the mother as well as the child.

PREVIOUSLY in this column I have written of "Blessings Before and After Childbirth" published by Mrs. Richard A. Weider of Rochester as a loving memorial of a son lost in World War II. I have also written on the beautiful and consoling ceremony of "Churrying."

This ceremony was almost forgotten by many in the hurry of modern life, but it is being revived today as modern mothers find that no matter and Spock are, no matter how carefully the pediatrician baby is more than a bottle and a book is needed to bring up a well balanced child.

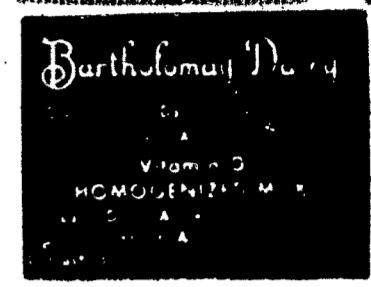
