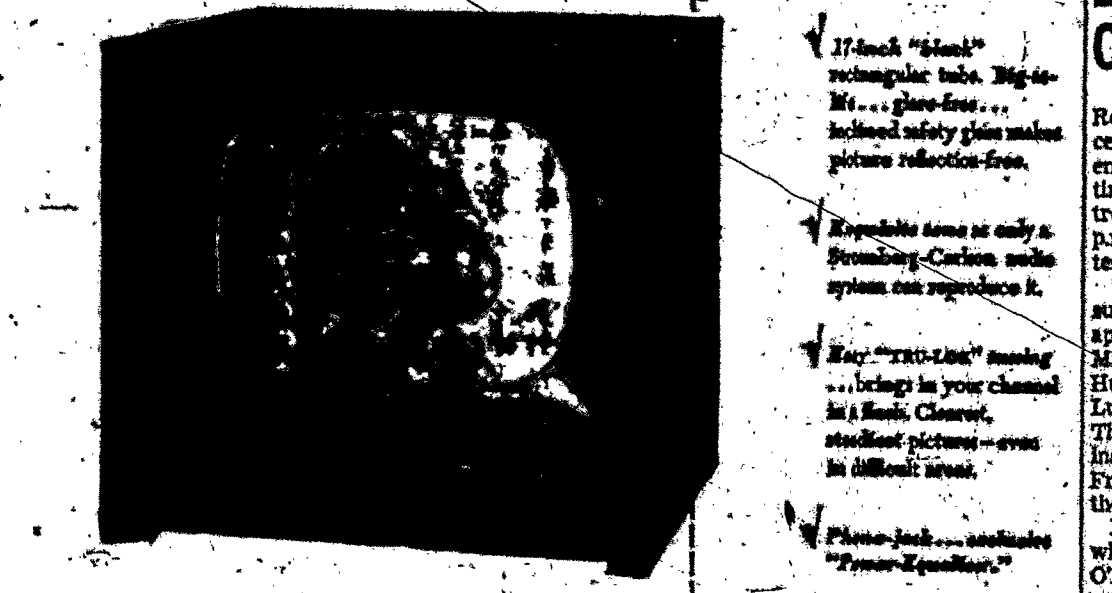
80 Catholic Women's Club Members Open Fund Drive
