**Famed Violinist's Concert Booked At S. H. Academy**

John Creighton Murray, internationally-famed violin virtuoso who made his Rochester debut last year, will be guest artist at a concert for the Academy of the Sacred Heart Charity-Fund Drive in the school gymnasium, Prince St., Wednesday evening, Feb. 13 at 8:15 p.m. After four years in the U. S. Army from 1942 to 1946, Mr. Murray travelled Europe until 1948 in a triumphant concert tour. For the past four years he has been giving concerts in the United States, Canada and Central America.

**Vatican Radio Corrects Refugee Journalist Reports**

London—(NC)—Vatican Radio has sharply rebuked "overzealous" refugee journalists who spread exaggerations or falsehoods about Jewish conditions in Hungary. Vatican Radio administered its rebuke by quoting from an article in Az Est, an organ of refugee Hungarian Catholics. The broadcast went particularly into the cases of the Rev. Richard Horvath, secretary general of the government-sponsored "peace committee for priests," and the Rev. Istvan Balogh, who once served as chairman of the committee.

"THE REFUGEE press," Vatican Radio stated, quoting Az Est, "in its overzealousness or for lack of suitable material has often overshoot its target of late lies." Lies cannot be combated by lies.

The broadcast cited one refugee journal as stating that Father Horvath was compelled to ask for another assignment because he was boycotted by his flock. "The truth is that he did not ask for a different assignment and continues to remain pastor of Saint Irene Church," the broadcast said.

Father Balogh was described by one refugee journal as dis regarding an excommunication imposed on him and returning to his priestly functions.

"THE FACTS are as follows," the broadcast said. "On account of disobedience, Istvan Balogh was suspended some years ago
