OTHER SPEAKERS in the lecture-series will be: March 11, "Impediments, Annulments, Divorces," the Rev. John E. McCafferty, J.C.D.; March 18, "What Is Allowed, What Is Forbidden in Marriage," the Rev. John T. Callahan; March 25, "The Psychology of Marriage," Robert J. Shaffer, M.D.; April 1, "The Psychology of Marriage," the Rev. Charles G. Langworthy.

The Rev. Kieran J. Hickey, O. Carm., moderator of the group, commenting on the course, restated previously declared aims: "This course is intended to supplement and not supplant the marriage instructions which are given by Catholic pastors to couples before marriage. The course is intended to be a partial remedy for the present situation in marriage where actual figures tell us there is failure for every third couple who marry."
