Social Security Asked For Clergy In College Posts

Washington, D. C. (RNS)—Congress has been urged to extend social security coverage to ordained ministers employed in teaching or administrative posts in schools and colleges.

A resolution proposing this was adopted by the 33rd annual meeting here of the Association of American Colleges.

The association said no violation of the Church-State relationship would be involved in bringing this group of clergymen under the law. They said that "exclusion of such individuals from coverage under the Social Security Act constitutes a discrimination against them."

The resolution specifically stated that the association was not urging social security coverage for those performing the ministerial function.

Coverage was proposed in cases where ordained, commissioned, or licensed ministers are performing duties as teachers or administrators in denominational or church-related institutions of higher learning, such duties being in no way related to the active exercise of the ministry.

Family Life Group Lists Congressman

Columbus, O. (NC)—Representative Eugene J. McCarthy of Minnesota will be one of the featured speakers at the 1932 National Catholic Conference on Family Life, which will be held here from Mar. 24 to 26.

Before he entered politics, McCarthy was widely known as a Catholic educator. He taught at St. Joseph's University, Collegeville, Minn., and later headed the sociology department at St. Thomas College, St. Paul, Minn. Bishop Michael J. Ready of Columbus, who will be host to the convention, and the Rev. Dr. Edgar Schmiedeler, O.S.B., director of the Family Life Bureau, National Catholic Welfare Conference, will be in charge of arrangements.

'Health For Youth Month' Opens Mar. 1

Fifth Annual Observance of "Health For Youth Month" will open on Saturday, March 1, sponsored by the Junior Health Committee of the Health Association of Rochester and Monroe County, a group of high school juniors and seniors.

Purpose of the observance is to teach young people about existing health facilities in the community, to show youth their part in Community Health and to teach teenagers the responsibility they have with regard to their own health.

"Health For Youth Month" as proclaimed by Mayor Samuel Dicker will feature four live radio broadcasts, panel discussions with Parent and Teen-age groups, contests in the schools on health posters, health radio scripts and news and feature articles on health appearing in school papers.
