Christian Reading Urged By Fr. Ehmann In Lent

The inner joy and peace gained through the love of God can be augmented by good reading, the Rev. Benedict Ehmann told 150 gathered at St. Christopher's Library, Elmira, for the tenth annual observance of Catholic Book Week, Sunday.

Father Ehmann, pastor of St. Mary's of the Lake Church, Watkins Glen, used the Catholic Book Week theme, "Christian Reading for Joyous Living," as his topic.

MUCH OF WHAT is found in modern periodicals is valueless as a means of giving greater Christian insight and closer union with God, he said. One needs to read expressively to enjoy full meaning of a worthwhile book. During Lent when fasting is required for the body, feasting on great literature can be enjoyed by the mind.

Father Ehmann urged that one or two books be chosen for careful study during Lent. He suggested a guided reading of the Bible. The lives of the saints, the true heroes of God, and their own writings were recommended by the speaker.

Such books as Frank Sheed's translation of Confessions of St. Augustine, Autobiography of St. Theresa, the Little Flower, as well as the biographies of St. Francis Xavier, John Bosco, St. Francis of Assisi, were those suggested by the speaker.

Father Ehmann showed how one can grow in the understanding of all men by reading selections from the following works: Salvation of the Nations by Jean Danielou; Beyond East and West by John C. H. Wu; Through Eastern Eyes by Henry Van Straelen. These books give opportunity for an understanding of our Eastern neighbors.

THE SEEDS planted by the early Christian missionaries, he said, will in the future take root and Christianity will finish the circuit of the globe. A passage read from Autobiography of a Hunted Priest translated by Philip Caraman illustrated the joy and peace that are possible through the love of God even during great persecutions.

Mrs. Katherine C. Lynch introduced the speaker. Yvonne Schell gave several vocal selections. Mrs. James Mallon, newly elected president of the Elmira Diocese Council of Catholic Women was also introduced. Mrs. Edmund Maloney presided.
