Chancery Official To Give Next Marriage Series Talk

Auburn—"Impediments, Annulments and Divorce" will be the subject discussed by the Rev. John E. McCafferty, J.C.D., Official, Diocesan Matrimonial Tribunal, Rochester, at the second session of the Auburn Diocesan Marriage Preparation Course, Tuesday, March 11, at the Knights of Columbus Home, Genesee Street, Auburn.

MRS. FRANK I. DOYLE, chairman of the Family and Parent Education Committee of the Auburn Diocesan Council, Diocesan Council of Catholic Women which is sponsoring the course, announces that Dr. McCafferty would be introduced to his Auburn audience by the Rev. Kieran J. Hickey, O. Carm., moderator of the diocesan council.

"True Values for Marriage" was the opening talk given by the Rev. Albert J. Shannon, professor of English at St. Andrew's Seminary, March 4.

In a poetic and moving talk, Father Shannon pointed out that the only true values for marriage are those set forth by Christ himself as promulgated through His Church. He admonished his hearers that the only true and lasting happiness of marriage is based upon these same Christian values.
