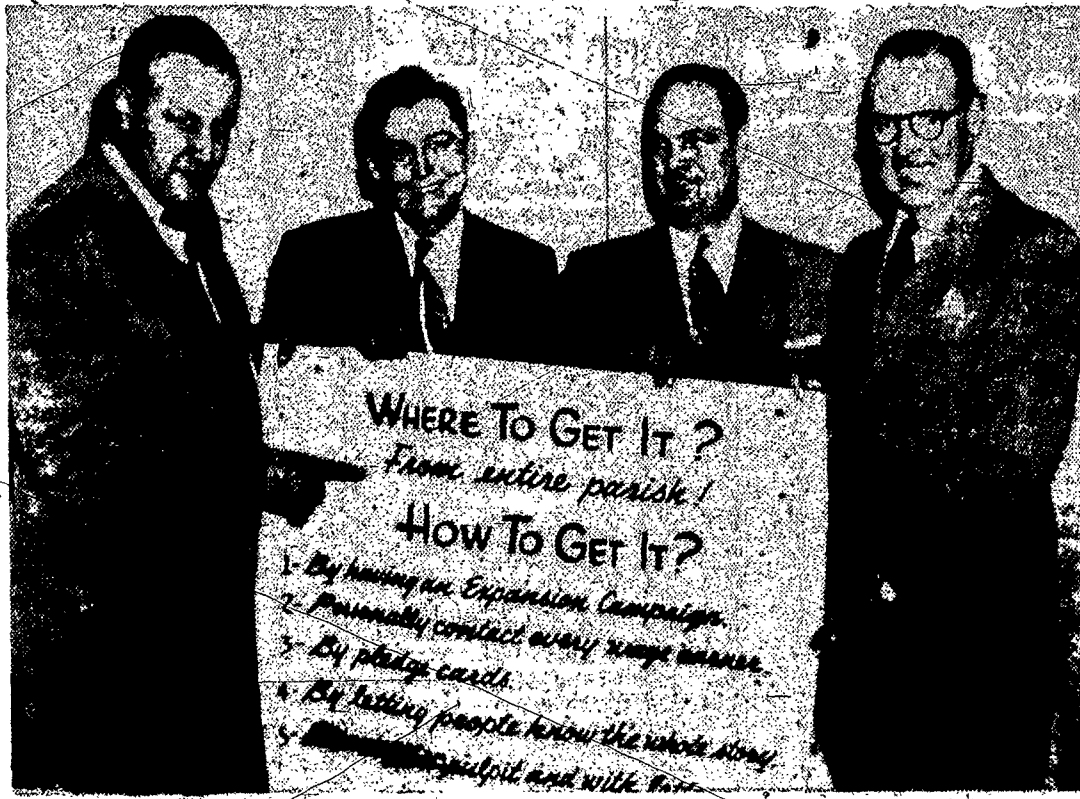
500 Men Attend Breakfast Of Post Office Holy Name
