AMONG WOMEN
Saint of Annoyances

This week I should like again to quote from a letter from Mrs. Rosalia Loritz, chairman of the Spiritual Development Committee of the Diocesan Council of Catholic Women, in which she passes on to us some suggestions which she has received from other women in our own diocese.

One woman says, "I always bless myself before answering the telephone or the door because, if for one little moment I have thought of God, it is much easier to speak gently and to be patient."

ANY ONE who because of defense restrictions or financial necessity must share with others on a "party line" knows that patience is often needed in trying to obtain use of the line. However, conversations with many women who use party lines have revealed to me that in most instances charity and patience are practiced in such group participation of a single telephone line.

For petty annoyances of this sort I find great inspiration in the life of St. Noel Chabanel, one of the martyrs venerated at Auriesville here in our own state. At the time of the canonization of the Martyrs a group picture was prepared for display in St. Peter's as is customary on such a great occasion.

The Holy Father, in approving the plans for the display of the pictures requested that a special picture of St. Noel be prepared and displayed separately because he said that St. Noel's martyrdom had been an especially difficult kind.

St. Noel did not breathe out his last minutes, hours and days, as did the other Jesuit Martyrs of North America in an almost unbelievable prolonged torture. When death came it was merciful and swift but his martyrdom came in his daily living with the Indians, every detail of whose life was repugnant to his delicate and refined nature.

The program is under the direction of Mrs. Martha O. Moran, director of the department of physical education, and Miss Jeanette Lortscher, president of the Women's Athletic Association.

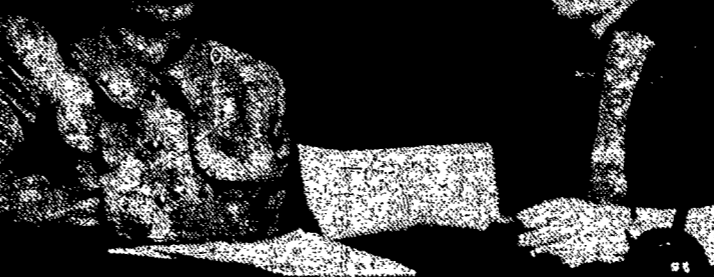
