**DeSales Boys Take Part In
 Armed Forces Day Contest**

Geneva — Interest among boys of DeSales and Geneva High Schools here is high in a contest which will give winners prominent roles in the observance of Armed Forces Day at Geneva and at Sampson Air Force Base on May 17.

Two Geneva boys will be chosen. One will become a "general for a day" and the other a "colonel." Both will act as special aides to Major General Morris B. Harbold, commanding officer at Sampson, for the day. They will accompany him wherever his duties take him all day long.

THE BOYS selected will be seniors at the two high schools. Selection will be made through essay contests in both schools. The boys will write essay of not more than 500 words on "Why We Honor Our Armed Forces."

In each school the best essay will be selected by the teachers and submitted for final judging by a special committee to be supplied by the Armed Forces Day Committee.

Essays will be judged, first for subject material, second for spelling and English, and third, for neatness. The essays will be in handwriting. They must be in the hands of the judges by May 9.

Awarding of the prizes will take place May 14 in a special assembly in whichever school wins first place. The Sampsonaires, singing group from the air base, will appear. One of the higher officers from the base will present the awards.
