Cornell Educator Flays Dr. Conant School Statement

Cornell University Professor John M. MacDonald, guest speaker at the 25th annual birthday dinner of the "Fellowship of Catholic Women's Club" at the Barren Stranahan Hotel last week, argued against statements made recently by Dr. James E. Conant, president of the American Association of School Administrators in Boston.

Professor MacDonald asserted that to eliminate all private schools would lead this country towards totalitarianism, stating that "Government-controlled education for all children results in the necessary foundation for dictatorship."

During the Catholic school system, Professor MacDonald said that it created no divisions and was in accord in any way with American tradition.

St. Joseph's College Opens Four Year Nursing Course

St. Joseph College at Emmitsburg, Md. has announced the opening of the new Division of Nursing which offers a four year basic degree course. The four year program in nursing is being introduced for the first time in Maryland.

The college is conducted by the Daughters of St. Vincent de Paul (Sisters of Charity), the same community in charge of St. Mary's Hospital, Rochester.

Students who register for the course will spend the first two academic years at the college acquiring a broad liberal arts foundation. During the first summer, students will obtain pre-

clinical experience in nursing at one of the cooperating hospitals. THE LAST two calendar years will be spent in obtaining clinical experience in hospitals conducted by the Daughters of Charity. For admission to this course, students must meet the entrance requirements of the college and in addition score satisfactorily on a pre-nursing test. A Bachelor of Science degree will be conferred on the satisfactory completion of the course. On graduation students will be eligible to take the State Board Examination for registration in Maryland and other States.
