Fulton Oursler, 59, Dies; Writing Led To Conversion

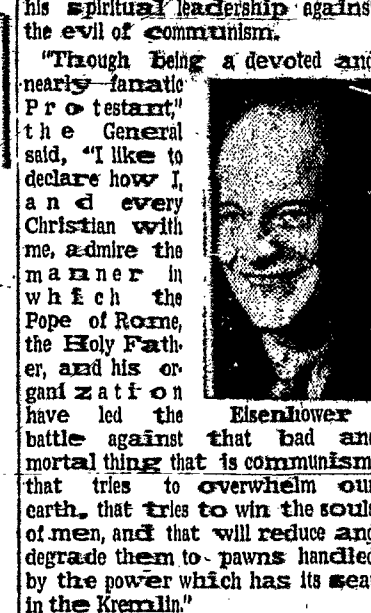

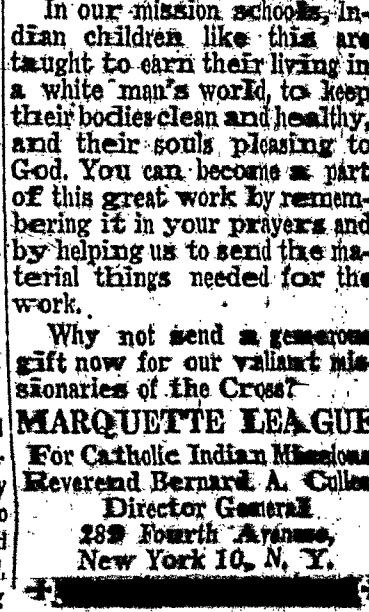
