**Father Nowak To Sing First Mass At St. Stanislaus**

Rev. Bernard Joseph Nowak, son of Stanislaus Nowak and the late Mary Javorold Nowak, will celebrate his first solemn Mass in St. Stanislaus Church, Rochester on Sunday, June 8, at 12 (Noon).

Father Nowak was ordained in the new Christ the King Chapel of Holy Cross Seminary, La Crosse, Wis. by Bishop John P. Treacy of LaCrosse on Saturday, May 31 in the diocese's largest class, numbering 13.

**THE NEWLY** ordained priest whose father and stepmother, Agnes Nowak are members of St. Stanislaus Parish will be assisted by his pastor the Rt. Rev. Msgr. Joseph A. Balcerak as assistant priest; Rev. Chester Skoczek, deacon and Rev. Matthew Sludars, subdeacon. Albert C. Ernest will be master of ceremonies. Sermon will be preached by the Rev. Leo J. Matuszewski.

Following the Mass, a public reception will be held at St. Stanislaus Parish Hall.

Father Nowak has three brothers: Edward, Rochester; Leo with the U. S. Army in Germany, and Frank, stationed in the U. S. Army at Fort Bragg, N. C.

Born in Rochester May 11, 1921, the young priest received his early education at St. Stanislaus School and Benjamin Franklin High School, Rochester. He attended St. Francis College, Burlington, Wis. for four years and received his theological training at St. John's Seminary, Little Rock, Ark., where he received his Bachelor of Arts degree in philosophy.
