Notre Dame Groups Select Locust Hill For Dance

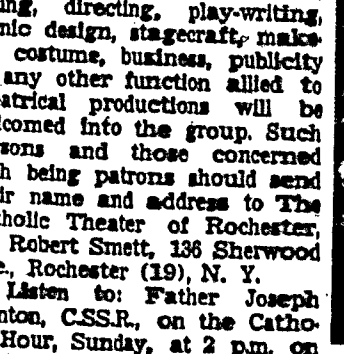
