### Trappist Head Lauds Aid To Monastery Here

Piffard — Laymen of the Rochester Diocese have assisted the year-old Trappist Monastery here "in the spirit of the early Christians," in the opinion of the Reverend Abbot General Don Gabriel Sorialis, O.C.S.O., of Rome, Italy. Pressure at the progress being made by the Trappists near Genesee — the only foundation of the Order of Cistercians of the Modern Observance in New York State — was expressed by Abbot General Gabriel last month during an official visitation to the Monastery of Our Lady of Christ the King of the Genesee here.

The Rev. M. Gerard McGinley, O.C.S.O., superior of the Genesee Valley community of monks, declared that the Abbot General "marveled at the charity that had been extended to this new foundation, and especially the fact that carpenters, electricians and many others have donated their Saturdays to help our monks construct their buildings."

THE ABBOT GENERAL, Father McGinley explained, is spending two months in the United States and Canada, visiting all Cistercian houses. A yearly visitation by a higher superior to each house is demanded by Cistercian Rule, he added. Abbot General Gabriel will attend the General Chapter of the Cistercians in Citeaux, France, Sept. 14.

Father McGinley added that he is hopeful the practice of voluntary Saturday assistance in the construction of their buildings may be continued through the summer, so that the more than 30 monks at the foundation along the Genesee River, now housed in a small farmhouse, may be able to occupy the new structures by next winter.

Besides the 13 volunteer helpers from the Rochester Diocese who aided them two weeks ago, there also were three men from the Buffalo Diocese, Father McGinley said.
