Mission For Colored 'Strikes It Rich'; TV Star Acts As Proxy For Priest

New York.—(NC)—A well-known TV star served as proxy for a priest and helped to "strike it rich" for a struggling Catholic mission in South Carolina.

The story began when Walt Frame, producer of the CBS-TV and radio program, "Strike It Rich," received a letter from the Rev. A. G. McCabe, O.P., of blessed Martin de Porres Mission in Columbia.

THE PRIEST, who works

among underprivileged Negroes of the CBS-TV show, "Eloise Salutes the Stars," and "Leave It To The Girls," volunteered to write to you and try to "Strike It Rich." He went on:

"Please understand that it is not for myself, for I have long ago taken a vow of poverty. It is for the 125 children whom we teach, feed and clothe here and for the many, many poor who come to us constantly for help."

Declaring that one special need of the mission was to pay for equipment ordered for its cafeteria, Father McCabe concluded his letter by saying: "May God bless you and the good you do for so many of His poor."


