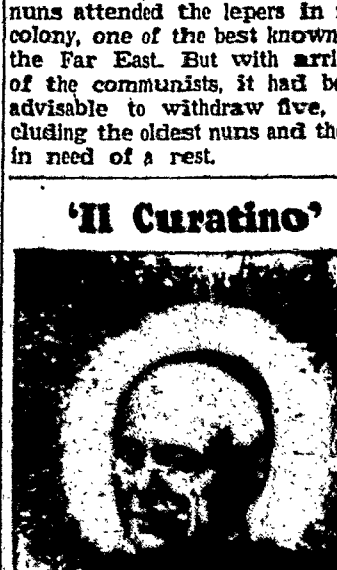
Adoption Applications
