Eddie Doherty In Dublin For Matt Talbot Data

Dublin — (AP) — An American newspaperman and author has been "walking in the footsteps of Matt Talbot" here, gathering material for a book on the life of the saintly Dublin laborer whose beatification cause is pending in Rome. He is Eddie Doherty, who has been commissioned by the Knickerbocker Publishing Company of Milwaukee, Wis., to write a book on the life of the one-time denizen who died in 1885 after years of extraordinary penance and piety.

Accompanied by Miss Doherty, the former Catholic League editor of Elmhurst, N.Y., Doherty has been building up people who know Matt Talbot and visiting the places associated with the saintly worker's career. Doherty was "well pleased" by his visit and deeply impressed by the mental picture of Matt Talbot he has formed. Mr. Doherty commented: "It is the sort of holy apostle we want in the U.S. today — one who carries the torch that lights an eternal flame."

Recalling that his grandmother came from County Donegal and his father's family traces its name to Mayo, Mr. Doherty described Ireland as the most truly Catholic country he has visited.

Belgian Priest Tried In Belgian Court

Brussels — (AP) — Father Pierre Michalson, a Belgian Catholic missionary, who had spent 30 years in North China, was tried here after being expelled by Chinese Communist officials. The priest said that he had been tried by a "people's court" of 300 villagers in the mission territory at Sui on the eastern border of the Sun Shan Province. He was accused of being an "imperialist."

Some of his accusers referred to incidents which took place here on twenty years ago, Father Michalson said.

Northwest Bishop Fosters Mexican Migrant Customs

Falmouth, Wash. — (AP) — Bishop Joseph P. Dougherty of Falmouth not only preaches to the Mexicans in his diocese in their own tongue but he has them the Mass and the Sacraments surrounded with customs of their native land.

Hundreds of migrants in a storage shed are being taught to pray in the Catholic churches in the Falmouth valley.

His Excellency Samboy Bishop Dougherty celebrated Mass at 5 a.m. in St. Joseph's Church, Snohomish, and preached a sermon in Spanish to the Mexicans who completely filled the church. Mass at sunrise is a traditional custom in Mexico.

After the Mass, Bishop Dougherty welcomed 100 small children, many of them infants in arms. Communion at an early age is another Mexican custom.

His Excellency said the Church permits Bishops to establish Communion in homes when in his judgment this is for the welfare of souls. The opportunity for the Mexican children to be confirmed should not be neglected, the Bishop said, because it might mean for a number of years the families who are migrating.
