

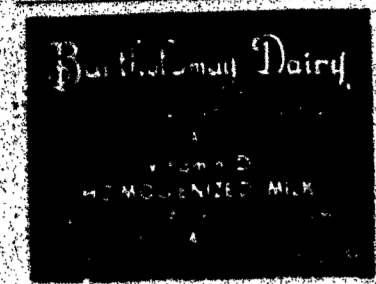
### Convert Guild Meeting Set At Seminary On Monday

### Bishop Kearney To Attend Knights Of St. John Meet

His Excellency Bishop Kearney as supreme spiritual adviser will attend the supreme convention of the Knights of St. John and Ladies Auxiliaries in Indianapolis, Indiana from Saturday, July 5 to Monday, July 7.

The convention will be formally opened on Monday, July 7 with a Pontifical Military Mass in St. Peter and Paul's Cathedral.

Sessions of the convention will continue Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, July 8, 9 and 10 with election of officers and installation on the last day.

The colorful street parade for all the knights and Auxiliary uniformed units will take place at 7 p.m. on Monday, July 8. All non-uniformed members are also expected to parade.

The convention program includes the famed Indianapolis Speedway, a national golf tournament, prize drills and entertainment for visiting women.

### First AEF Chaplain Dies In Syracuse

Rev. Francis P. Joyce, said to have been the first U. S. Catholic chaplain to go overseas with the A.E.F. in World War I, died June 28, 1952, in Syracuse after a long illness. He was 77.

Father Joyce went to France with the 1st Army Division under the late Gen. John J. Pershing in July, 1917. He served as a chaplain for 17 years.

The aged priest was living in retirement in Syracuse.
