**Card. Spellman To Attend K. of C. National Parley**

Los Angeles - (NC) - His Eminence Francis Cardinal Spellman, Archbishop of New York, will preside at a Pontifical Mass during the 70th annual supreme convention of the Knights of Columbus here in the City of the Angels.

Celebrant will be Bishop Charles F. Buddy of San Diego, and Archbishop J. Francis A. McIntyre of Los Angeles will preach. A PUBLIC reception will be held in Cardinal Spellman's honor at the Pasadena Civic Auditorium. The four-day convention, opening August 12, will be the first held in Los Angeles by the K. of C. since 1905, three years after the organization was established in the West.

California is particularly rich in the traditions of the Catholic Church. Throughout the romantic history of the state, from the earliest days, men of the Church have been instrumental in its foundation and progress.

SIXTY YEARS after Christopher Columbus discovered the New World, the Portuguese admiral, Juan Rodriguez Cabrillo, sailing in ships of Catholic Spain, reached the coast of California and explored the region from San Diego to Santa Barbara. That was in 1542.

Proceeds from the day-long fete, in which more than 20 German-American societies will participate, will be turned over to West German Relief Agencies, according to William Wittman, an officer of the Catholic Kolping Society and president of the Federation of German-American Societies.

**Old Age Benefits To Increase On Oct. 3**

Nearly every family in the Rochester area now getting old age and survivors insurance payments will receive more money beginning with the September payments due about Oct. 3. If the increase does not show on a check when it arrives early in October, and an increase is due, a later check will make up the difference. It is not necessary for people already receiving benefits to apply for the increased payments. Kenneth G. Haxton, manager of the Rochester social security office, stated today that the recent amendments to the law will mean monthly payment increases ranging from \$5 to \$8.60 for practically all of the 13,000 retired insured workers in Rochester.
