UR Divine Lord never made a distinction between races or colors, U not even between the East and West. It is however an his-torical fact that the Western World is Christian and the Eastern World is not. The difficulty our missionaries have to face in India, Kores, Africa and Japan is to convince the Eastern people that Christianity is not Western. Added to this association of Westernness with Christian-ness is the Communist propaganda that the Western World is "imperalistic." Hence the missionaries are accusto of being "agents of imperialism."

There are three answers to this dilemma of how to bring the Divinity of Christianity to Eastern peoples without it being wrred with "Western-mess."

"The first way is to educate native priests, Brothers and Sisters. Communism prospers in China, India, Hungary and Poland by making the natives. Communists and thus creating the illusion that Communism is natural to their culture. The American people would not be satisfied if most of their bishops and clergy came from a foreign country; the Eastern people are entitled to share! the same sentiments. Hence let the Church in Africa be governed by Africans, the Church in Japan by Japanese, etc. Some progress in this direction is being made. In Africa today there are 1500 other native seminarians in 44 major seminaries. In Tanganyika there is a major seminarian for every 4,000 Catholics; in Nyasaland one for every 6,600; in the Congo one for every 10,000 Catholics. A seminarian can be completely educated for \$600 or supported for \$150 a year. A Catholic in America who wants an adopted son a prist will make this sacrifice for the sake of the faith. Hong Kong -(NC)- The Rev Georges Germain, S. J., former rector of Aurora University, Shanghal, was arrested by the communist security police on the night of July 19-20, according to information received here.

THE #1-YEAR-OLD French Jesult was serving as procurator for the Shanghal diocese and the Jeauit Order in China at the time of his arrest.
