### Polio Committee Recruits Nurses Here For West

The Polio Nursing Committee of the Rochester Chapter, American Red Cross received an appeal last week to recruit nurses in this area for Polio assignment in the mid-West where one hundred nurses are needed at the present time. First to respond to the appeal from Rochester were Miss Gertrude MacLaughlan of 688 Genesee Park Blvd. and Miss Eileen St. John of 158 Syke Street. Both are registered nurses who have recently been engaged in private duty cases.

Miss Gertrude MacLaughlan and Miss St. John left Wednesday afternoon, August 6, by plane for the Indiana University Medical Center, at Indianapolis, Indiana, where they will assume their duties in caring for polio patients. More nurses are needed at the Indianapolis Center as well as in other mid-western localities.

Nurses recruited for Polio duty become temporary employees of the hospital where they serve and are paid \$275 per month. Assignment time will vary with the
