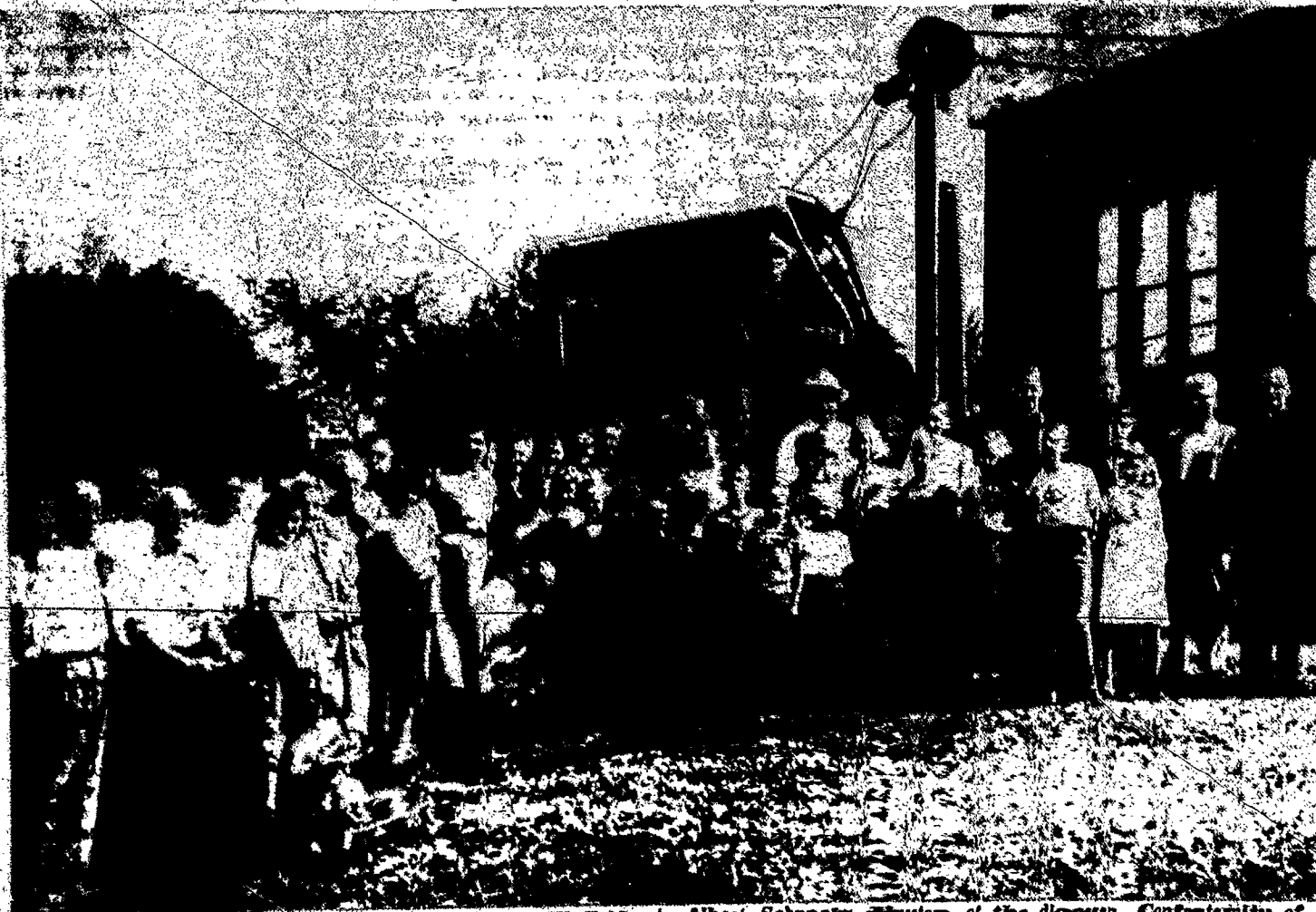


### St. Andrew's Parish School Addition Groundbreaking

Albert Schnack, director of the diocesan Confraternity of Christian Doctrine, former assistant, first church and school for the parish were dedicated on the same date, Aug. 13, in 1914. Monsignor Eckl founded the parish. Frank Quinlan is architect of the new school addition for which Frank G. Magglo & Sons, Inc. is general contractor.

### Bishop Founder Of Two Papers

Dallas, Tex. — (NC) — Bishop Thomas K. Gorman, Coadjutor to the Bishop of Dallas, has announced that The Texas Catholic will soon make its initial appearance as the official weekly newspaper of the Diocese of Dallas. Prior to his installation in Dallas, last May, Bishop Gorman was for 21 years the Bishop of Reno, where he founded The Nevada Register.

### Polish Consul Quits Post

Chicago — (NC) — Zygmunt Fabiatis, Polish consul here who resigned and asked the United States for asylum, said "as consul in Chicago I felt that I did not represent the real Polish interests." "I couldn't stand the political situation in Poland," the consul declared.

### Minister Elected Korea "Veep"

Pusan, Korea — (RNS) — A retired Presbyterian minister, the Rev. Tal-yong Han, was chosen Vice President of the Republic of Korea in the national elections that returned President Syngman Rhee, a Methodist layman, to office. Mr. Han, who succeeds Sung-soo Kim, a Presbyterian layman, is 78 years old.

Cleveland — (NC) — Benedictine monks at the new St. Andrew Abbey here will chant their office in an air-conditioned chapel. Air conditioning of the ground-level chapel was essential because only one side of the chapel has windows.

## Holy See Streamlines Spiritual Apostolate To World Emigrants

Vatican City — (NC) — The Church has taken steps to streamline last far-flung work of providing spiritual care for millions of migrants all over the world.

This is the purpose of an Apostolic Constitution issued by the Holy See, which defines, coordinates and reorganizes the functions of various existing Church institutions in the field of worldwide aid to emigrants. Dated August 1, the document bears the title "Magna Facultas."

In PARAGRAPHS, the Constitution outlines the work of the Holy See in the field of emigration, and places in charge of the spiritual care for emigrants of the Latin Rite, which it received from Pope Pius XII. It provides for the establishment of a Supreme Council on Emigration under the jurisdiction of the Consistorial Congregation and defines the functions, under it, of the Delegate for Emigration. The latter office was established last November.

The Constitution sets forth the spiritual functions of ships' chaplains, giving them the faculties of pastors, except with regard to the Sacrament of Matrimony. In this connection, it affirms the jurisdiction of the Consistorial Congregation over the Apostolicship of the Sea, which decided two years ago to transfer its world secretariat from Glasgow, Scotland, to Rome.

INITIALLY, THE constitution states, emigrants, exiles, pilgrims and refugees should be ministered to by priests of their own nationality, as was the case in the foreign settlement in medieval times.

The document recalls the efforts of recent Popes, from Leo XIII on to the present Pontiff, to cope with the problem by founding or encouraging societies and providing national centers for national groups in Europe, America, Australia and other countries, both for the Latin and the Oriental Rites.

Special reference is made to the enormous efforts of the Church during and since the last war to bring material and spiritual aid to the millions of refugees and homeless in Europe and Asia. It recalls the work of the Vatican Migration Office set up in September, 1946 and the efforts of the Holy See to aid "poor populations, only a minority of whom are Catholics" that are suffering as a result of the conflict in Palestine.

WHEREVER THE Church has found herself faced with such grave needs, the document says, she has always been "in the forefront, doing the spadework, and not infrequently was left alone in the work of cultivation."

St. Paul's Pupils To Wear Green

Greening — Announcement has been made by Sister Mary Lammont, principal of St. Paul's Episcopal School, that this fall, for the first time pupils of the school will wear green.

Challenges for the girls will consist of green jumpsuits with white blouses. The boys will wear their green polo shirts, trousers and white shirts.

### Parents Briefed

London — (RNS) — The Vatican Radio reported that, for some time, Hungarian parents have been receiving 800 Florints (\$610) from the Communist Party for each child they refuse to have baptized.

The Constitution sets up rules to meet the need of providing spiritual assistance to the rising number of refugees and emigrants to Europe, America, Australia and the Philippines. The task of the Delegate for Emigration, it states, is to promote pastoral activity on behalf of emigrants of all nations and categories. It is his duty to coordinate competent offices and organizations, to recruit missionaries in the field of emigrant aid and to assist them, to handle publicity and to stimulate all initiatives concerned with the spiritual and material welfare of emigrants.

The present delegate is Msgr. Emilio Rossi, a member of the Consistorial Congregation, who represented the Holy See as an observer at the International Emigration Conference held last October in Naples under the auspices of the International Labor Office.

Auxiliary Bishop Named In Richmond

Washington — (NC) — The Very Rev. Joseph E. Holzer, director of the Diocesan Missionary Fathers of the Diocese of Richmond, has been named by Bishop Pope Pius XII to be Auxiliary Bishop of Richmond and Auxiliary to Bishop Peter L. Jackson of Richmond.

Card. Faulhaber Successor Named

Vatican City — (NC) — Pope Pius XII has named Bishop Josef Wendel of Bayreuth to be Archbishop of Munich and Freising.

The appointment of the 61-year-old Bishop, 34 years the last pastor by the death of Michael Cardinal von Faulhaber, one of the longest serving bishops in Germany, Cardinal von Faulhaber died last June 12, he was 88.

The Munich see, which had in the eighth century been under the jurisdiction of the Holy See, was transferred to the Bavarian see in 1818.
