

days as a member of Britain's new. self-created "nobility" would he no more remarkable than his attack upon dictatorships in "The Great Dictator" while he himself. as absolute fuler over his own little Hollywood empire, continued to behave like any one or all three of them.

THE CHAPLIN LIFE and character have erupted a mass of stark contradictions. He has indulged a whim for

autocratic alcofness while protesting a palsion for democratic ways. He has pinched dimes and scattered dollars. He has hobnobbed with Soviet sycophants and supporters while attempting to laugh off his own position with such remarks as, "I am a comedian, not a Communist.

He has pandered to persons of position and privilege while posing as a champion of the common man; been 'photo-graphed with Winston Churchill while agitating for a second front to ald Stalin.

He has rudely cold-shouldered the working press of America while opening wide his home and hospitality to by-line writers from the leftlet press of foreign countries.

By coincidence or conscious design he has been especially tractable with those who happened to have been to Soviet Russia, while refusing to grant interviews to identified anti-Communist writers on our own American newspapers.

Chaplin has remained, through more than 40 years of phenomenal professional success in these United States, a subject of Great Britain, while making marriage with various American women and becoming the father of six American children.

He has characterized himself as an enigma on the fringe of Hollywood's human oddities. He has created among the tolerant public of America who now charitably dismiss his private scandals, serious doubt and distrust concerning his civic loyalty. For this he has only himself to hisme


