HONG KONG—(NC)—The Chinese Reds have again struck at the small contingent of foreign bishops still in China. They ousted Archbishop Paulin Albovy of Nanning, a 72-year-old member of the Paris Foreign Mission Society.

Archbishop Albovy had been imprisoned by the Reds last year. Earlier this year he was permitted to leave his prison cell. He was the victim of a hurried "expulsion meeting" before his ouster.
