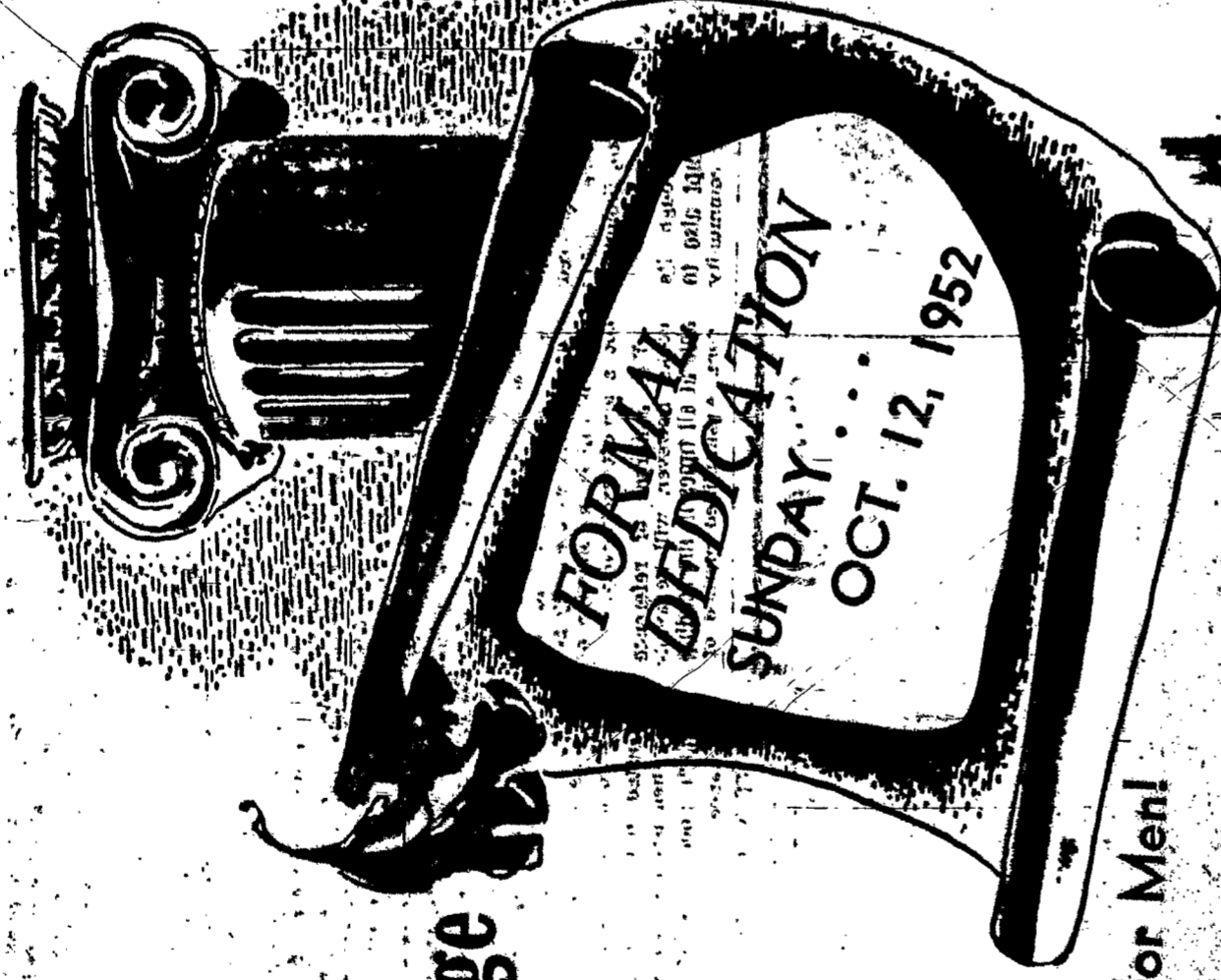

Curricula Of Studies Aims At Varied Fields

At St. John Fisher College's three possible degrees: the B.A., Bachelor of Arts; and the B.S., Bachelor of Science; and the B.B.A., Bachelor of Business Administration. No matter which degree a student pursues there are some courses that all must take, that is, Theology, Philosophy, English and Language.

In all programs except the B.B.A. program a student must take a physical science. He may choose among Biology, Chemistry and Physics. In the B.B.A. program or the B.S. program with a major in the Social Sciences he need not take any pure mathematics.

Generally speaking those students who follow the B.A. program want a general, well-rounded education. They want to know what they want and choose the B.A. program along a general choice of courses that interest them. Or they may want to concentrate but not care to concentrate so completely on one field. For students uncertain about their interests or vocational goals, the B.S. with a major in the Social Sciences offers another starting point.

Students following leading to the B.S. degree may specialize in the fields of Biology, Chemistry or Mathematics. These are thoroughly concentrated courses giving a complete foundation for graduate work, or an introduction to certain phases of industry

and commerce. Pre-medical and pre-dental students follow a combination of courses chosen from the above. The B.B.A. program is designed for engineering students. Re-engineering students transfer to the School of Engineering at the University of Rochester under the usual conditions. There they may complete their engineering work under a three year cooperative program.

Students who take courses leading to the B.S. degree with a major in the social sciences find an ideal pre-law program. This program is, also, an excellent preparation for teaching in this field and for the high art of politics whether domestic or foreign. It gives a good background for people who want to work in contact with government. The pre-law student can also take his preparation in a B.A. program.

The student following courses leading to the B.B.A. degree will major either in accounting or general business. In this latter course he will make a selection of courses giving him a background of knowledge against which he can find his own niche in the world of business.

A quick look at the table of courses in the college catalog will indicate the wide range in which a student may carry on his studies. Interested students should write to the Registrar, St. John Fisher College, Rochester, New York requesting a catalog.
