### Bishop Explains Aims of Catholic Nurse Group

Auburn — His Excellency Bishop Kearney was speaker at the ninth annual banquet held by Auburn Council of Catholic Nurses at Springville Inn, Thursday evening, Nov. 20. The Bishop outlined for the 120 nurses present the purpose of an organization for Catholic Nurses.

He posed the questions: 1. Why do we separate ourselves as a Catholic group? 2. Why regardless of our education, school of nursing affiliation, do we establish an organization based on our Catholic Faith? 3. Do we have a purpose and is it worthwhile?

Then answering the question he gave the following reasons for an organization of Catholic nurses. 1. The gift of faith which each Catholic receives at Baptism must color all his attitudes in his personal life.

2. A Catholic organization accentuates our faith, the Bishop stated. Such an organization expresses our Faith. Every human emotion needs expression. This is true also of supernatural faith. External manifestation reacts for happiness here and hereafter.

### Bp. McEntegart To Found Carmel in Ogdensburg

Ogdensburg — A new Carmelite monastery, the first within the limits of the Diocese of Ogdensburg, and the 47th in the United States, is being established at Saranac Lake this month.

Bishop Bryan J. Entegart revealed here in an announcement certain to bring new joy to the faithful of this North Country. The new monastery, permission to found which was granted by the Sacred Congregation for Regulars in Rome, is being established by Bishop McEntegart, with the approval of Cardinal Spellman, in thanksgiving for the successful completion of the new St. Mary's Cathedral consecrated here two weeks ago.

IN ANNOUNCING the coming of the Carmelite nuns to the North Country Bishop McEntegart said: "In thanksgiving for the guidance and assistance given us by Our Blessed Mother in building our Cathedral, we have undertaken the establishment of this new convent under her patronage. Its purpose will be constant intercession with Almighty God for the needs of the Church, particularly here in the North Country, for the sanctification of priests, and for the salvation of souls."
