

### Released China Missioner To Visit Relatives Here

Rev. Maurice Kavanaugh, C.M., who spent 18 months imprisoned in Red China, is expected to visit relatives and friends in Rochester due to the efforts largely of Rep. Kenneth B. Keating of Rochester.

Father Kavanaugh will confer with the Very Rev. Msgr. John Randall, diocesan director, Society for the Propagation of the Faith when here.

The Vincentian Father had spent the last 26 years as a missionary in China prior to his arrest by the Communists. He is the cousin of Patrick J. Kavanaugh of 25 Oriole St. and of Andrew J. Kavanaugh, Commissioner of Public Safety, Wilmington, Delaware.

He was released by the Reds in September and is now in Hong Kong. He planned to return to his native Ireland by way of the United States but had difficulty arranging a visa.
