# Tito Reds Decision To Expel Archbishop Stepinac Reported

Paris- (NC) -Cardinal-designate Aloysius Stepinac, Archbishop of Zagreb, may be forcibly expelled from Yugoslavia by Tito, according to a report reaching here.

The report comes from a highly placed official in Belgrade whose name obviously cannot be revealed






