Boston — (NC) — Msgr. John O'Grady, secretary of the National Conference of Catholic Charities, declared here that land reform in Italy and economic aid in both India and Italy are stemming the tide of communism. But he warned that America's immigration policy is unchanged and unless such organizations as War Relief Services — National Catholic Welfare continue their aid programs, these gains may be lost.

Cardinal Mindszenty 4 Years Under Prison Sentence—Life To Go

Vienna — (NC) — "The Hungarian People's Republic sentences you to life imprisonment." Exactly four years ago (Feb. 8, 1949) the angry voice of communist Judge Vilmos Olti imposed sentence on His Eminence Cardinal Mindszenty, the Primate of Hungary, for alleged treason, espionage and currency violation.

THE CARDINAL'S name has since been practically forgotten by the official Hungarian press and radio, except for its occasional use as a synonym for treason, "reaction" and imperialistic tendencies. But all indications reaching here are that the Cardinal's name is a household word of reverence among the millions of Catholics who are practicing their faith under constantly mounting opposition from Hungary's Red government.

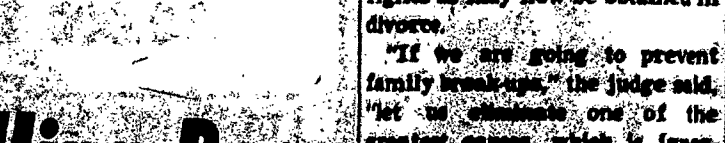
With the anniversary of the Cardinal's "trial" and imprisonment comes news that one of the Red officials involved now has himself felt the heavy hand of communist persecution.

"It has failed because it is fundamentally wrong," he continued. "It is contrary to the natural law, which is divine law.
