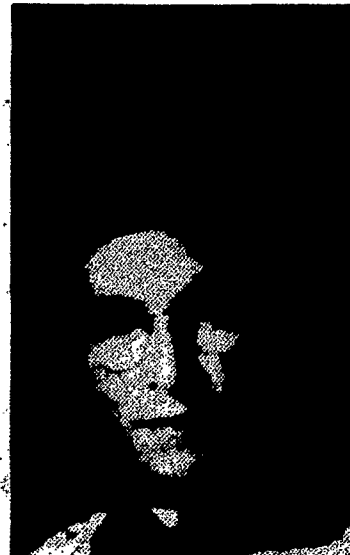

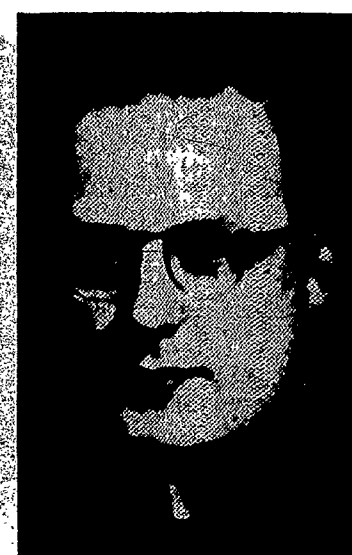

A large turnout of Holy Name Society men of Monroe County is expected at the mid-winter meeting of Rochester Diocese Holy Name Union, Sunday, Feb. 15 in Columbus Civic Center ballroom, according to Toole.

Two speakers will discuss topics of timely interest to the Catholic laymen.

AN ADDRESS on "The Holy Name Men" will be given by the Rev. Matthew Tobin, C.S.S.R., of St. Joseph's Church. Father Tobin has been more than 25 years in the Redemptorist order.

He has served at missions at home and in Puerto Rico. He was a chaplain with the U. S. Marines in World War 2 and was a chaplain of the Anchor Club comprised of Knights of Columbus on the police force of New York City. He is at present chaplain of Rochester Council, K. of C. and of the First Friday Luncheon Club.

The Rev. Patrick J. Flynn, diocesan spiritual director of the Holy Name Society will speak on "New Rules in The Eucharistic Fast." Father Flynn is editor of the Catholic Courier Journal, diocesan newspaper.

EVERY PARISH in the Rochester Diocese is expected to be represented at the gathering. At least eight officers and delegates are expected with as many more of the men as can attend.

With Father Flynn and President Toole, Diocesan officers will include Richard S. Torpey, vice president; Frank J. Lange, secretary; Henry J. Schoenherr, treasurer and John W. Degus, marshal.

Martin Q. Moll, diocesan union president and former officers of both the deanery and diocesan union will be present.

Fr. Wall To Mark 25 Years As Pastor In Canandaigua

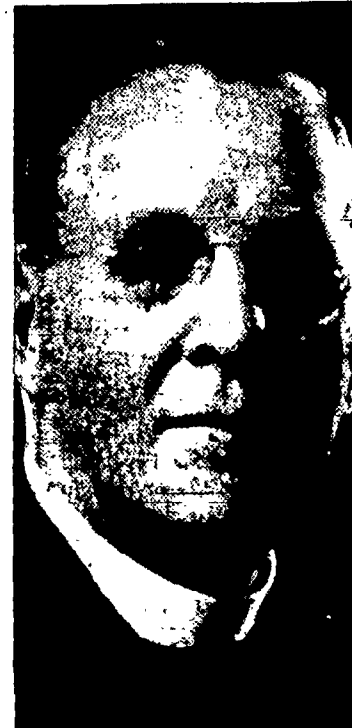
The Rev. Michael C. J. Wall will celebrate his silver jubilee as pastor of St. Mary's Church, Canandaigua on Sunday, Feb. 15 at the 11 a.m. Mass, according to the parish publication.

Father Wall, ordained June 12, 1897 by the late Bishop Bernard McQuaid is the oldest priest in the Diocese of Rochester.

To mark the observance of 25 years in his present pastorate, members of St. Mary's Holy Name and Rosary Societies are sponsoring a dinner for the clergy of the Geneva Deanery at the Canandaigua Hotel. Father Wall will be guest of honor.

PASTOR OF St. Mary's Church since 1928, Father Wall has renovated the parochial school, the rectory and convent. He has enlarged the sanctuary and decorated the church. A marble altar was built under his direction and a new baptistry installed. Completing the improvements to the church, he installed the Westminster chimes.

Prior to being assigned to Canandaigua, Father Wall in 1897 was named assistant pastor, Holy Family Church, Auburn; 1898, pastor of St. Theresa's, Stanley and St. Mary's, Rushville; 1903, pastor, St. Mary's, Horseheads and Elmira Heights; 1909, pastor, St. Patrick's, Dansville; 1921, pastor, St. Agnes, Avon.
