Mrs. Bowden was in charge of the program. Colorful slides were shown of the Girl Scouts Chalet in Switzerland.

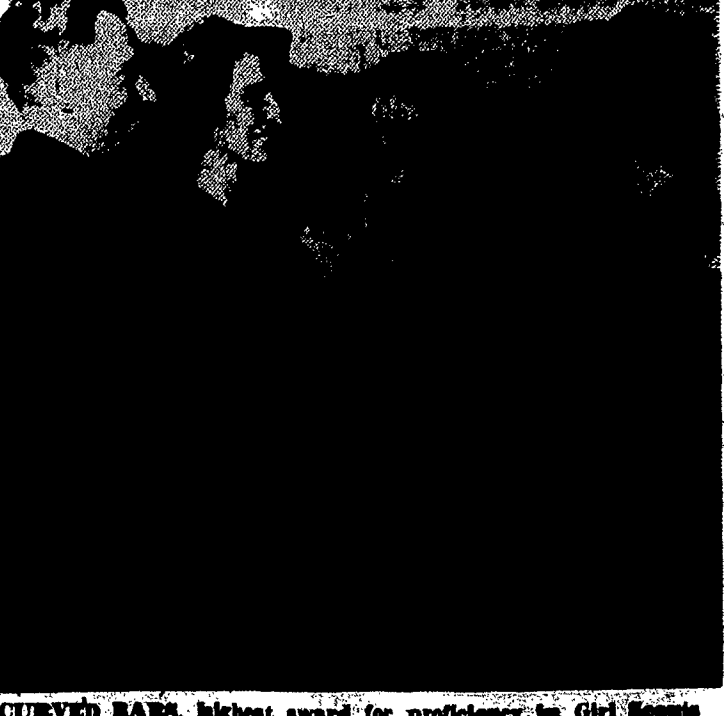
Part of the program was a ceremony in which the girl contributed to the friendship fund. Singing and folk dancing were enjoyed. Refreshments were served in the cafeteria.
