Burial was in St. Mary's Cemetery. Mrs. Painter was a member of St. Patrick's Parish and the Stella Maris Society.

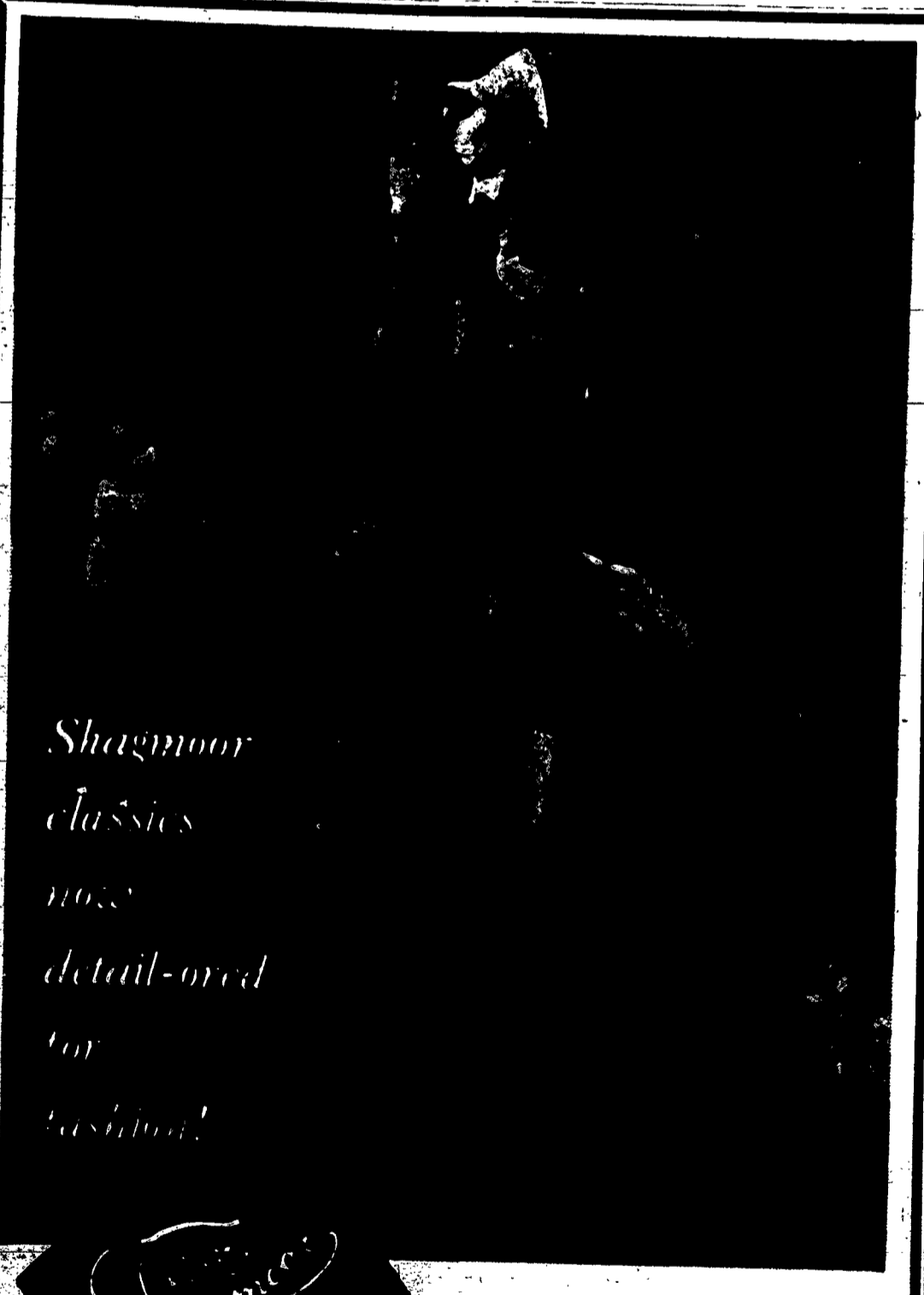
