**McNally Honor Fund Established By St. Bona Men**

Establishment of the John D. McNally Bonaventure Scholarship Fund was announced this week following incorporation and election of officers. His Excellency Bishop Kearney has consented to be honorary chairman of the Board of Directors, newly elected officers said. Elected at the Board of Directors meeting to head the work are: Thomas J. Brynes, president; Leo T. Sullivan, first vice president; William L. Bennett, second vice president; Robert C. Conroy, secretary and John C. Kopec, treasurer. PURPOSES of the fund as outlined by the officers are: "to establish grant, provide, maintain and administer scholarships at St. Bonaventure University for and on behalf of students residing in the county of Monroe, State of New York and to otherwise assist said students who are deemed qualified to matriculate and continue as students at St. Bonaventure University." The fund will perpetuate the name of the late John D. (Yarnol) McNally, an honor graduate in the class of 1930, which class founded the Rochester Chapter of the St. Bonaventure Alumni Association. **Earth Turned, Work Begins On St. James School Annex**

Ground for a four-room addition to St. James School, Brockly Road was broken by the Rev. Francis M. Feeney, pastor, last Sunday at 4:45 p.m. Actual construction started Tuesday, St. Patrick's Day with the arrival of the contractor on the scene. The new addition which was provided for in the original plans as far as central heating plant is concerned, will be of sillicote block with buff brick exterior, completely fireproof. THE FLOORS will be of asphalt tile, the eight foot corridors will be of unglazed tile, sillicote block and glass block. The new classrooms as well as the original classrooms will be painted in lively colors which considering the expansive window area and fluorescent lights will provide excellent visibility at all times, Father Feeney said. On last Sunday afternoon just before the ground breaking ceremony, four babies were baptized, bringing the number of baptisms at St. James to a total of 280, 21 of whom were baptized this far in 1953. This clearly points to the evident need for this new school addition according to Father Feeney.
