**Highest School Press Award
Merited By Nazareth Paper**

"The Gabriel," Nazareth Academy newspaper, received a Medalist rating, highest award given in the Columbia Scholastic Press Association Survey, according to Col. Joseph Murphy, Association Director, at the annual convention in New York last week.

About 4,000 students and moderators registered including 21 Nazareth Academy students and 2 faculty advisors.

Highlight of the program was a luncheon at the Waldorf Astoria with Brig. Gen. Carlos P. Romulo of the United Nations as guest speaker.

Awards were posted in the rotunda of the Law Memorial Library where high rating school papers were on display.

Ratings are based on a point system covering news, editorials and features, typography and make up.

CERTIFICATES ARE given to papers receiving first, second or third class rating. First class is given to papers receiving more than 850 points. Medalist is conferred on a small percentage of first class papers from the top scorers in the first class group.

"The Gabriel" and "The Lantern" year book, now hold medalist honors. Ratings held by the school newspaper include: Medalist - Columbia Scholastic Press Association; International Honor Award-Quill and Scroll; All-Catholic - Catholic School Press Association; All New York - Empire State Scholastic Press Association.

"The Lantern" holds Medalist; All American-National Press Association and All Catholic-Catholic School Press Association.

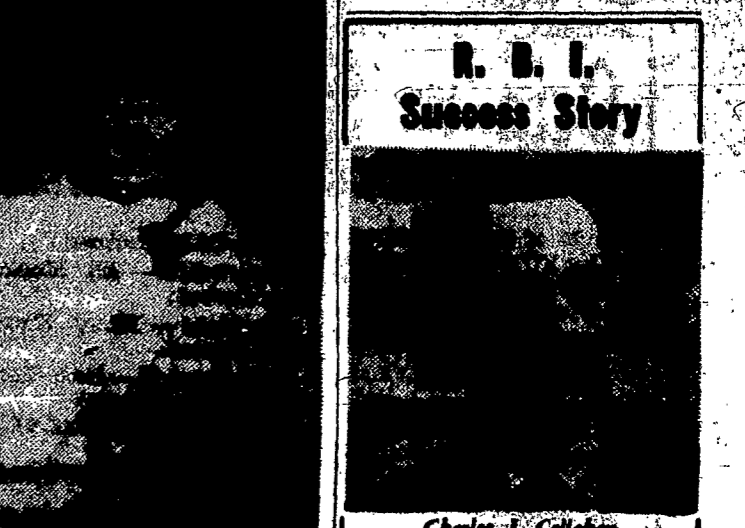
