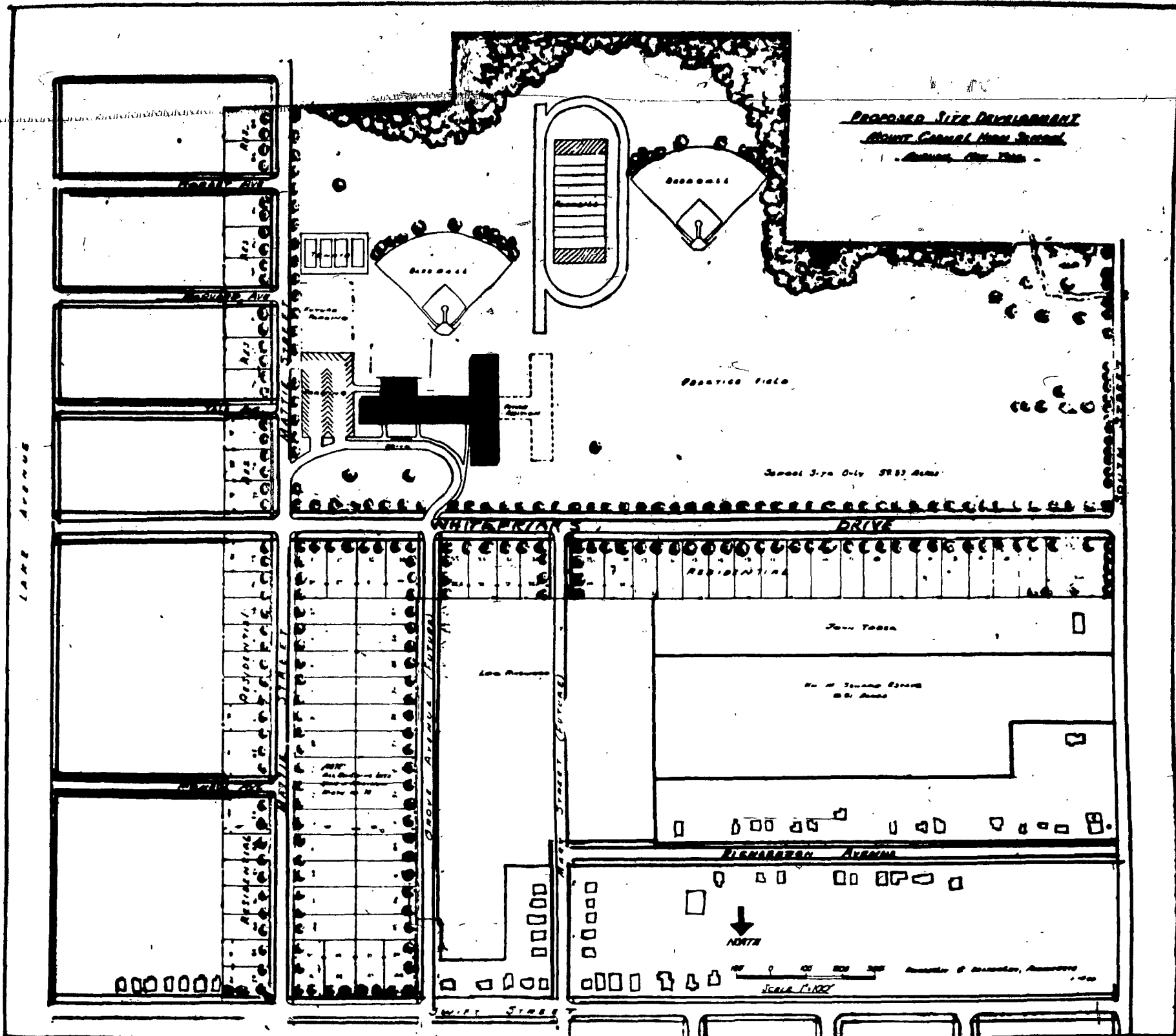


Plan For Mt. Carmel High School Tract



Priest Called 'David Harum' In Real Estate Venture

Garfield Heights, O. — (NC) — They're calling Father Hugh Gallagher the "David Harum" of the real estate world hereabouts and telling the story of how he parlayed an eight-and-one-half tract into a 23 and one-half acres.

Some years ago, the Cleveland diocese acquired the smaller tract here in this Cleveland suburb with a view to eventually building a church and school.

Around the time that the land was acquired, Irish-born Father Gallagher was off at the wars, serving as a chaplain in both the European and Pacific theaters.

MEANWHILE THE Garfield Heights area began to expand, with new residential communities springing up all over the suburb. So when Father Gallagher came back to the Cleveland diocese, Archbishop Edward F. Hoban of Cleveland instructed him to stake out the tract and start building up the new parish of St. Monica.

Father Gallagher went to work with a will and it wasn't long before things were ready for the

groundbreaking. The Mayors of STONE AND BRICK were ordered and steam shovels were ready to start work, when Father Gallagher received a visit from Solomon Siegel, who owned the adjoining 23 and one-half acres tract of land. At the request of Mr. Siegel, a building contractor, work was held up while he discussed "a deal" with Father Gallagher.

As things turned out, Father Gallagher with the approval of Archbishop Hoban swapped his eight-and-one-half acres for Mr. Siegel's 23 and one-half. It seems the main sewer pipe serving the community run smack down the middle of Father Gallagher's land. Mr. Siegel was planning to build houses on his land and it would prove costly to connect his houses with the sewer. On the smaller tract, that cost is saved for him.

Statue of Christ Proposed For Auburn High To Guard Denver

Denver — (NC) — A gigantic statue of Christ will soon watch over the city of Denver. The 22-foot stone sculpture of the Sacred Heart which will be erected sometime this summer in the Rocky Mountain foothills west of Denver will be visible from the city and floodlighted at night.

Now being completed in Naples, Italy, the statue will stand above the grotto of St. Francis Xavier Cabrini, the Colorado shrine that is visited annually by hundreds of pilgrims. At its base, a flagstone court will be built to enshrine a Sacred Heart which Mother Cabrini fashioned from pure white rocks.

The school, the letter said, is a contribution from the people of Auburn and will be located on the best possible site to the south of Whitefriars Drive. The proposed location provides the best area for the development of play fields and future expansion which will be appreciated by students and many of the Auburn people.
