

# Courier Journal Circulation - Parish Report

Following is the report of the CATHOLIC COURIER JOURNAL subscription campaign through parishes of the diocese in last month's campaign.

Eighty-four parishes reported subscriptions totaling from 85 per cent to 100 per cent of their parishioners. These subscriptions, added to those received directly through the paper during the course of the year, bring the total to more than \$3,000 for the first time—the largest circulation of any ABC-audited weekly newspaper in New York State outside the Metropolitan area.
