Is your doctor "too laboratory minded"? Dr. Louis Bauer, president of the American Medical Association, believes that a lot of doctors are... that they "need to use eyes, ears and fingers" more often, as old-time doctors did.

We thought of our favorite, Dr. Mary Tinley, who has been practicing medicine for 53 years. Though Aunt Mary knows laboratories and their value, she still relies on those five keen senses that God gave her.

Looking back, I remember her on-the-spot diagnoses when we'd be home with the children: "This little fellow's getting too much sugar in his formula." Aunt Mary could tell by feeling a baby's arm.

When we were growing up, we saw Aunt Mary nearly every day. She'd wave to us in the morning as we walked to school. She'd be driving home from an all-night case in the old Ford with the familiar license plate "68"—the year of her birth.

It never occurred to us to wonder how Aunt Mary could look so fresh and happy after "little or sleep. To us she just looked like Aunt Mary—crisp red hair curling over a high-collared white dress with pearl necklace, blue eyes serene and smiling.

When I was a young girl, Aunt Mary, in a white gown, red hair pinned back, would look at me and say, "You're a good girl, aren't you?"

### AMONG WOMEN

#### Gamma Globulin

A Leader's Alert, sent out by the National Council of Catholic Women in cooperation with the National Foundation for Infantile Paralysis, is known as Bulletin One and deals with Gamma Globulin.

Using the title "Short Gamma Demand," the bulletin declares: "You should know more about these facts on polio prevention: 'Fact I—Gamma globulin is a fraction of human blood which contains polio-fighting antibodies. The same pint of blood will furnish gamma globulin for polio serum albumen for the Armed Forces.'

'Fact II—An inoculation of gamma globulin is effective for a brief time in preventing crippling paralysis caused by polio. 'Fact III—Gamma globulin (GG) is in very short supply for the polio season 1953.

'Fact IV—All available GG is being pooled in a national stockpile for distribution under the direction of the Office of Defense Mobilization.

'Fact V—All GG will be allocated in accordance with a national distribution plan recommended by an Advisory Committee of the National Research Council.

'Fact VI—All GG will be distributed free of charge to the State and Territorial Health Officers.

'Fact VII—GG is not a vaccine. A vaccine giving longer protection against polio is still a prime concern of March of Dimes supported scientists. But no vaccine is available for use during 1953.

The bulletin continues: "You will want to have accurate information about this unique public education project which concerns all parents. To answer the inquiries of the members of your organization and other citizens, you should know more about the nation's first massive war of prevention against paralytic polio."
